RECORD OF VOTES TAKEN:

Motion to approve January minutes by Laurie Dallon, second by Shauna Warnick.

ALL MATTERS PROPOSED, DISCUSSED, OR DECIDED:

- Talked about putting the school values on flags. Brenda is pricing them out. We will continue to look at what that would cost the school.
- Discussed putting PBIS into goal #1 of the School Improvement plan.
- While discussing goal #2 of the school improvement plan Brenda brought up how the categories have changed. We can no longer pay Kelly Services from Trust land funds.
- Jacoy asked about the “wording” the goal and if we would have to re-write it. A possibility what it would sound like if re-written: We could use PBIS “by the end of the year”, use the word “demonstrate”
- Also in goal #2 we talked about how tracking the number of D and F grades as well as using data from SAGE testing as a way to measure performance.
- Goal #3 deals with Social Media. Some parents did not like all of the notifications they receive when a student is absent. They didn’t mind knowing, just felt like at times it was a little much (annoying).
- Goal #4 led us into a conversation about how Science in 7th grade will become a full year course beginning in the Fall of 2017. English will no longer be two periods or a “pod” as it has been.

- With the move away from the “pod” in 7th grade English there was a discussion about how that may affect the amount of reading done in those English classes. Brenda’s “dream plan” is to implement critical reading skills in ALL classes.
- Discussed the possibility of having Scott Buck come into March SCC meeting to have him address what may happen as we move away from 2 English classes in 7th grade. Jacoy suggested it may be better to have Reilly Ryan come and talk as he has had experience teaching both 7th and 8th grades.
- We are trying to keep those “at risk” in English.
