**RECORD OF VOTES TAKEN:**

**ALL MATTERS PROPOSED, DISCUSSED, OR DECIDED:**

- Mrs. Burr reviewed the Trustlands report and went over the data regarding the school grades. There was a short discussion regarding Trustlands and how that money is being spent to improve the data and results for the coming years SAGE scores.
- Review some “Cool Data” put together by Mr. Rowley. The data showed a decrease in tardies and deficient grades compared to three previous years.
